Offering a class-leading combination of ventilation, fit, light weight and safety, the helmet combines ConeHead™ technology with the all-new MRAS II fit system to ensure a comfortable and familiar fit experience. A mountain biking version of the helmet is also available. (RRP \$189).



KALI PRANA GRAFFITTI This motocross helmet may be colourful and light weight, but when it comes to safety and protection it's a true heavyweight. Weighing in at just 1200 grams, the carbon outer shell houses the COMPOSITE FUSION™ Plus construction based on ConeHead™ technology. The dual-density CONTEGO™ liner then provides the softest materials next to your head, with the integrated airflow system providing further comfort. (RRP \$399).



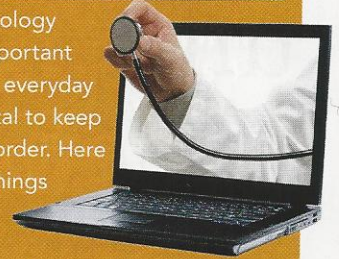
KALI NAZA Bringing the same technology-driven performance of the Kali Prana to road motorcycle helmets, the NAZA™ carbon motorbike helmet combines advanced strength in a feature rich, ultra-light design. The cutting-edge shape includes dual-density cheek pads for an individualised fit, an integrated ventilation system to ensure the rider's maximum performance and a quick-release, anti-scratch and anti-fog face shield. Comes with a five-year limited warranty (RRP \$429).
